Come with Thanksgiving is an anthem for harvest, Thanksgiving, or general praise services that incorporates the beloved hymn tune *KREMSE*. Suggested corresponding lectionary readings include 1 Chronicles 29: 9-13, Psalm 100, Isaiah 63: 16 and 1 Corinthians 15: 57. One basic homiletical theme is giving thanks to our Creator and Redeemer with songs of praise, words of devotion and lives of Christian service.

In rehearsal, strive for a lyric legato with a feeling of one pulse per measure and sensitive text declamation. The congregation may join in singing the hymn tune melody in verses 2 and 4. The descant on the final verse may be sung by a few sopranos and baritones.

Lloyd Larson is a free-lance composer living in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Formerly the Associate Pastor for Music and Worship at Meadow Park Church in Columbus, Ohio, he is an ordained minister and widely published composer. Larson earned a B.A. from Anderson (IN) University and an M.C.M. from Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky.
