Ephesians 6: 1-4

"Children, it is right to obey your parents in the Lord.

'Honor your father and your mother'—

this is the first commandment with a promise:

'so that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.'

And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to anger,

but bring them up in the ways of the Lord."

Special Moments is an anthem that celebrates the Christian family. It is appropriate for worship throughout the year, especially for baptism, child or family dedication, and Mother's or Father's Day. Suggested corresponding scripture readings include Exodus 20: 8-12, Proverbs 4: 1-9, Ephesians 6: 1-4 and Colossians 3: 12-17. One basic homiletical theme is the responsibility of the Christian family to train its children in the ways of the Lord.

In rehearsal, strive for a lyric legato enlivened by a strong sense of the underlying eighth note pulse. The phrases are clearly defined and should be shaped dynamically according to the natural rise and fall of the melodic contour. For a short choral response to a baptism of child dedication, perform only mm. 1-36.
