Jesus said to them again, "Truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep.

All who came before Me were thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them.

I am the gate; anyone who enters through Me will be saved.

Anyone who enters by Me will come in and go out and find pasture.

I am the good shepherd; I know My sheep, and My sheep know Me as the Father knows Me, and I know the Father and I lay down My life for My sheep."

My Shepherd Will Supply My Need is a beloved folk hymn found in Walker's Southern Harmony. Its text is a paraphrase by Isaac Watts (1674-1748) of Psalm 23. The hymn time is also known as Resignation.

This lovely arrangement by Jay Althouse opens quietly, with unison voices (opt. soloists). The anthem should be sung with sensitive text declaration and some freedom of movement. It is appropriate for performance throughout the year especially All Saints', the fourth Sunday of Eastertide, Lent and funeral services. Suggested corresponding scripture readings include 1 Samuel 16: 1-13, Psalm 23, John 9: 1-41 & 10: 1-30, 1 John 3: 16-24, 1 Peter 2: 19-25 and Ephesians 5: 8-14. One basic homiletical theme is Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who nurtures His sheep and gives His the for their salvation.
