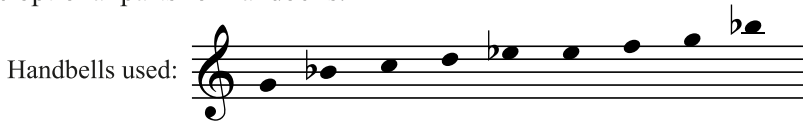

Performance Notes

- 1) A HYMN TRILOGY may be sung in several creative ways:
 - a) A mini hymn sing
 - b) An extended concertato for a thanksgiving themed service
 - c) By omitting the congregational part, any of the three hymn settings may be sung individually as an anthem.
- 2) Each of the hymn settings provides an opportunity for congregational singing. Congregational parts are included on pages 29–31.
- 3) Two of the hymn settings, *O God, Our Help in Ages Past* and *O for a Thousand Tongues to Sing*, have optional parts for children's choir.
- 4) Two of the hymn settings, *O God, Our Help in Ages Past* and *Now Thank We All Our God*, have optional parts for handbells.



- 5) Except for use as a mini hymn sing, the narrations are optional and can be read by one or more readers.
