**Advent Candlelight Carol** is a charming adaptation of the Burgundian carol (commonly known as *Patapan*) that also incorporates the opening motive of *Let All Mortal Flesh Keep Silence*. Featuring optional percussion (hand drum and triangle) and congregational singing, it is especially appropriate for Advent processionals or candlelighting ceremonies.

When used in conjunction with weekly candlelighting ceremonies, this anthem may be performed verse by verse, adding a verse with each subsequent week. It may also be performed without ceremony as a regular Advent anthem.

Suggested corresponding Scripture readings include Isaiah 9:2-7 and 40:1-5, Matthew 4:12-17 and Luke 1:67-79. One basic homiletical theme is preparing for the coming of the Messiah, who is the Light of Salvation.

Anna Laura Page received a Bachelor of Music degree in Vocal Music Education with a concentration in piano and a Master of Music degree in Music Theory with a concentration in organ from the University of Kentucky. Active as a composer, chrician, and organist, she has served as Handbell Editor for the Accents Signature Music for the Celebrating Grace Hymnal. In addition, she has received the ASCAP Standards Award for the past several years. She has taught organ as an adjunct faculty member at Mercer University in Macon, Georgia, and theory/organ as an adjunct faculty member at Lander University in Greenwood, South Carolina. She served as director of the Austin Peay Community Children's Chorus in Clarksville, Tennessee for three years and later served as Handbell Music Editor for Alfred Publishing Co., Inc. Her publications include choral works for children, youth, and adults, and compositions for handbells, organ and piano. She is married to Dr. Oscar C. Page, President Emeritus of Austin College in Sherman, Texas, and they have two grown children and two granddaughters.

Jean Anne Shafferman is Director of Music at College Hill Presbyterian Church in Easton, Pennsylvania. She has authored over 90 choral works, 30 children's musicals and collections, and four SATB Christmas cantatas. She is retired from a long career in church music publishing, having served as Harold Flammer Church Editor for Shawnee Press; as Director of Church Choral Publications for Alfred Publishing Company; and as Managing Editor of church choral publications for The Lorenz Corporation. Active as a singer, she has been a member of the famed Bach Chor of Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, since 1983.


