RESURRECTION INTROIT is an energetic, a cappella call to worship for Easter morning. The 6/8 meter should feel buoyant and quick, with crisp and clean articulation. Choirs desiring a shorter version may choose to end the introit at measure 16. Keep the energy driving to the end of the piece with no ritard. Keyboard may gently double the voices if necessary.

Bob Krogstad - Composer, arranger and conductor. Bob Krogstad, established himself as a well-known figure in the music business. His arrangements for the London Symphony were featured on the Hallmark Cards annual Christmas albums (1996-2000). His music can also be heard on the albums of singers Mel Torrne, Maureen McGovern, Michael Crawford, Natalie Cole, James Darren, Sandi Patty and Kathy Troccoli, among others.

Ken Parker is the founding director of Christian Arts Ministries, building on more than 45 years' involvement in local church ministry as a pastor, worship leader and dramatist. Ken has served as youth pastor, senior pastor and minister of music in churches in Missouri, Ohio, Michigan and Minnesota. For more than two decades he was the minister of worship at Grace Church in Edina, then Eden Prairie, Minnesota, where he developed large scale, outreach oriented musicals and passion plays that communicated the gospel and impacted the lives of many thousands of individuals. He is the composer of several church musicals, including the best-selling "Heaven Rejoices." He resides in Colorado Springs, Colorado.
